

Regulation of Expressway Traffic Officer

Subject: Prohibition of Over-Gross Laden Weight Van & Pick Up to Drive on Expressway
B.E. 2556 (2013)

For traffic convenience and safety in expressway, by virtue of the provisions of Section 139 (1) of Land Traffic Act B.E. 2522 (1979) in conjunction with Section 42 and Section 43 of Expressway Authority of Thailand Act B.E. 2550 (2007) as the law containing certain provisions in relation to the restriction of right and liberty of a person, in respect of which Section 29 and Section 34 of the Constitution of Kingdom of Thailand, permits by virtue of the provisions of law, be it, therefore, the Deputy Governor for Operation of Expressway Authority of Thailand, on behalf of the expressway traffic officer pursuant to the Ministry of Transport's Announcement on Deputation of Officers for Expressway Traffic Function dated 24th September B.E. 2553 (2010), hereby issues the Regulation as follows:

Clause 1 This Regulation is called "Regulation of Expressway Traffic Officer on Prohibition of Over-Gross Laden Weight Van & Pick Up to Drive in Expressway B.E. 2556 (2013)".

Clause 2 This Regulation shall come into force as from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Clause 3 Van & Pick Up having not more than 1,600 kilogram of vehicle weight and 4,000 kilogram of gross laden weight shall be prohibited to drive on expressway.

Clause 4 This Regulation shall not come into force with Expressway Authority of Thailand's vehicle(s) and police officer's vehicle(s) that are on duty, and vehicle(s) permitted from the expressway traffic officer.
